BLACKJACK - RULES OF PLAY

- BETS MUST BE PLACE BEFORE RECEIVING ANY CARDS.
- DEALER MUST DRAW ON 16 AND STAND ON ANY COUNT OF 17 OR MORE.
- ACES MAY BE COUNTED AS 1 OR 11.
- BLACKJACK (ANY 2 CARD 21) PAYS 2 TO 1.
- PAIRS MAY BE SPLIT PROVIDING THAT EQUAL BETS ARE PLACED ON EACH HAND.
 - A BLACKJACK OBTAINED ON A SPLIT PAIR PAYS EVEN MONEY.
 - c) PAIRS MAY BE SPLIT ONLY ONCE.
 - d) WHEN SPLITTING ACES, THE PLAYER RECEIVES ONE CARD ONLY ON EACH ACE.
- HOUSE WINS ALL TIES.
- NO PREMIUM PAID ON FIVE CARDS UNDER 21. HAND COUNTS VALUE OF CARDS ONLY.
- PLAYERS MAY DOUBLE DOWN ON A 2 CARD COUNT OF 9, 10, OR 11 AND TAKE ONE ADDITIONAL CARD ONLY.
- INSURANCE BETS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- DECISION OF THE FLOORMAN IS FINAL.
